Sinful saltines

1 sleeve saltines

2 sticks butter

1 cup sugar

2 cups chocolate chips or chocolate melts

Line a cookie sheet with foil and spray with Pam. Crush sleeve of saltines and put on cookie sheet. Boil butter and sugar for 3 minutes until mixed. Pour over saltines. Bake 350° for 10 minutes. Put chocolate on top. Wait a few minutes and spread chocolate. Cool and break into pieces to serve.
